

The mission of the Kentucky Golf Foundation is to promote junior golf in Kentucky, as well as to maintain a home for the Kentucky Golf Hall of Fame and administrative offices for Kentucky's governing bodies for golf at Golf House Kentucky. Proceeds from the Annual Campaign benefit these efforts, which are highlighted below:

### Maintaining Golf House Kentucky and the Kentucky Golf Hall of Fame

- Donations assist in funding expansion and maintenance of displays in the Kentucky Golf Hall of Fame and in maintaining the facility and grounds at Golf House Kentucky. Since the opening of Golf House Kentucky, the Kentucky Golf Foundation has worked to establish the facility as THE home for golf in Kentucky, and has hosted leaders from the Women's Kentucky State Golf Association, the Kentucky Turfgrass Council, the First Tee of Louisville, the Kentuckiana Chapter of the Golf Course Superintendents Association of America, the Kentucky Chapter of the Club Managers Association of America, the PGA of America, the USGA, the Kentucky Golf Association, the Kentucky Section PGA, and the Kentucky Senior Golf Association. Since opening in late 2006, the facility has added numerous items to the Kentucky Golf Hall of Fame, including the 1967 Masters Trophy, the Women's Kentucky State Amateur Championship Trophy, and a display dedicated to the 2008 Ryder Cup.

### To Promote Junior Golf in Kentucky, the Kentucky Golf Foundation has:

- Provided financial support to the Kentucky PGA Foundation, which has provided assistance in recent years to organizations such as Special Olympics Kentucky, First

Tee Chapters in Kentucky (Lexington, Louisville, Owensboro, and Pine Mountain), the Don Fightmaster Golf Outing for Exceptional Children, and junior golf programs at Hidden Cove State Park Golf Course and Mt. Sterling Elementary School.

- Provided financial support to the Kentucky Senior Golf Association Foundation's Fred Allen Fund, which provides financial assistance to junior golfers from Kentucky who qualify for the United States Junior Amateur Championship and the United States Girls' Junior Championship.
- Provided financial support to the Kentucky High School Golf Championships by fielding a staff of qualified Rules Officials for the Championships. The Kentucky High School Golf Championships are among the finest in the United States, and support is vital to conducting these Championships in a first-class manner.
- Launched the Gay Brewer, Jr. Grant Program, which provides financial assistance to junior golfers from Kentucky with the ability and desire to compete at the regional and national level, but, are limited in their ability to do so due to financial constraints.

In 2002, the Kentucky Golf Foundation was formed as a joint effort between the Kentucky Golf Association and the Kentucky Section PGA. Among the purposes of the Foundation, which is a 501 (c) (3) charitable organization, is the promotion of junior golf, as well as construction of a central home (Golf House Kentucky) for golf administration in Kentucky, and to also serve as a home for the Kentucky Golf Hall of Fame. A capital campaign was launched in 2003, and on November 10, 2006, the doors to Golf House Kentucky were opened. Hundreds of individuals, along with a number of golf facilities, companies, and organizations stepped up to support the capital campaign and made Golf House Kentucky a reality.

It is in that spirit of support that the Kentucky Golf Foundation has launched the 2009 Kentucky Golf Foundation Annual Campaign as a means of securing annual support from those interested in supporting the organization and its many worthwhile efforts on behalf of golf in Kentucky.
