

## Teaching & Coaching Track Overview Certified Professional Program

### Teaching & Coaching CPP Requirements:

- Earn 250 Career Path Education Hours (CPE Hours)
- Complete Advisement
- Document attendance at a Teaching & Coaching Summit (within 2 years)
- Complete Capstone Requirement
- Teaching & Coaching Summit attendance documentation course



### CPP Registration Fee:

Includes access to the Library, PSU Certificate, Advisement course, and Teaching & Coaching career path Capstone. **Note: CPP Registration Fee includes 1-year access to the Education Portal for \$350. There is NO timeline for earning the CPP designation.**

### Career Path Education Hours (CPE) Options to Earn:

<b>Option 1: Library Courses</b>	Available in the Education Portal. Can earn up to 50 CPE Hours over and above the PSU certificate. Previously completed Specialized courses do not count towards CPE Hours. Must be newly completed courses.
<b>Option 2: PSU Certificate</b>	Available in the Education Portal. Earns 100 CPE Hours. Topic: Biomechanics of Golf
<b>Option 3: Outside Sources</b>	Link to Manage CPE Hours (including forms to submit requests) can be found on your Education Programs page on PGA.org. <b><i>A maximum of 25 CPE Hours per activity.</i></b>

### Outside Sources (additional information):

- Includes workshops, training, certifications, and advanced degrees.
- A list of options for earning CPE Hours from outside sources will be forthcoming on PGA.org.
- Those not already approved require approval by the PGA Education Department.
  - Submit on PGA.org by visiting the dashboard, then clicking Your Programs under Lifelong Learning, then Manage CPE Hours.
  - Documentation required for approval includes, but is not limited to, program outline/overview and hours of material covered.
  - Additional information may be requested for approval by the PGA Education Department.
- Activities for CPE Hours must be within the past two years.

### Capstone Options (Only 1 required):

<b>Option 1: PSU Certificate</b>	Applicable Capstone included in completion of the certificate. Topic: Biomechanics of Golf (100 CPE Hours)
