

Dave Peege – 2017

Dave has had an illustrious career on the golf course, winning championships as an amateur and a professional. Dave is a lifelong Louisville resident and four-time Kentucky Open winner; the second most in the history of this prestigious event. He attended the University of Mississippi, where he was a two-time first-team All-American, a two-time SEC Player of the Year, and a three-time first-team All-SEC selection. Dave still holds several Ole Miss University golfing records including being awarded the Ole Miss Athlete of the Year Award in 1984: the only golfer in Ole Miss history to ever win this award. Dave played on the PGA

Tour in 1992 and 1993 and has played in more than 100 PGA Tour events. Dave was a PGA Club Professional Apprentice for two years at Big Spring Country Club, and then spent several years as a teaching Professional, before he retired from the profession. Since retirement, Dave has spent much of his time giving back to the game by teaching junior clinics and assisting with the Trinity High School golf team. Along with his newest title, Kentucky Golf Hall of Fame member, he is also a member of the University of Mississippi Hall of Fame and the Trinity High School Hall of Fame. Dave is married to his wife, Lauren, and has two sons.
