



Betty Rowland Probasco - 1991

Betty Rowland Probasco, a resident of Kentucky for 23 years, captured five Women's Kentucky Amateur Championship titles. In 1950, she won the National Intercollegiate Championship, and in 1955, was a semi-finalist in the U.S. Women's Amateur Championships and won the Women's Southern Golf Association Championship. She also won the Women's Tennessee Amateur Championship eight times. In 1956, she was selected to the United States Curtis Cup Team, and served as Captain of the 1982 United States Curtis Cup team. She served on the USGA Women's Committee for over ten years, and served as President of both the Women's Kentucky State Golf Association and the Women's Tennessee Golf Association. She is a member of the Kentucky Athletic Hall of Fame, the Tennessee Sports Hall of Fame, the Tennessee Golf Hall of Fame and the Rollins College Sports Hall of Fame.
