Conditions of Play

Entries

The Kentucky State Amateur Championship has been conducted annually since 1911 and has crowned many of the Commonwealth's legendary golfers. Names such as Gay Brewer, Jr., Bobby Nicholas, Frank Beard, John Owens, Bill Musselman, Jodie Mudd and J.B. Holmes are now engraved on the championship trophy.

Field

The 156 player field is cut to the top 70 and ties after 36-holes of competition.

Format

This championship is the flagship tournament for the KGA and is contested over 54 holes of stroke play competition. Players reach the championship by either qualifying at a section site or earning an exemption into the championship field.

Practice Rounds

The official date of the practice round is June 17. Competitors will contact the Bowling Green Country Club Golf Shop to make arrangements for that date at (270) 842.4581.

Rules of Play

Play is governed by the 2012-2015 Rules of Golf and the Decisions based upon them published by the United States Golf Association and, where applicable, by the following Local Rules and Definitions. Appendix I refers to Appendix of Local Rules in the USGA Rules of Golf booklet. Pace of Play is strictly enforced.

Ties

In the event there is a tie for first place, a hole by hole playoff will be used to determine the winner. Hole #18 will be the first playoff hole. If additional holes are needed, the order will be as follows: Hole #15, Hole #16, Hole #17 and Hole #18. This will be the order of play until a winner is determined.

Prizes

All contestants reaching the final round and posting a 54 hole score will receive a gift certificate redeemable through the Bowling Green Country Club Golf Shop. Prizes will also be awarded in the following categories: Section Medalist, Low Scorer in each round, Low Junior, Low Senior, Low Public Links contestant, runner-up and champion.

SIMPSONVILLE – Murray State University golfer, Patrick Newcomb, successfully defended his 2011 Kentucky State Amateur Championship at Cardinal Club in Simpsonville, Kentucky with a 7-under par 206 total in 2012. Newcomb, who had Steady rounds of 68-67-71, finished four shots ahead of Ryan McCann (71-69-70) of Crestwood. Five golfers tied for third at 212, including: Bellarmine University golfer Bryan Ratterman,Davis Boland of Louisville, Matt Gann of Pineville and Eastern Kentucky University's Taylor Riggs. Newcomb started the day two shots ahead of junior golf standout, Tyler McDaniel, who lost a ball and took a triple bogey on the first hole and was unable to right the ship over the remaining 17 holes and also finished third.



"This felt different this year because I had been through this before. At the start I was thinking I was going to cruise. I was 9-under through 7. Then played #9 great, but had A three putt. It was a grind after that to keep it at even par for the day. I kept plodding along and hit a great shot from 250 yards out and made birdie on 13 and got it going from there," said Newcomb, who won his first Kentucky State Am at Kearney Hills Golf Links in Lexington. "This may take a little bit to sink in. I was thinking about that right after we finished. It was really exciting but I'm really beat up. The Cardinal Club really puts the pressure on you and you have to make good shots to score there," he said.

The Cardinal Club played to a par of 71 and 7,000 yards for the week.
