ENTRY FEE

\$125* (includes complimentary range balls & shirt)

*All successful qualifiers and exempt contestants will be charged an additional \$ 100.00 prior to the championship. This fee shall be paid at time of registration at the championship venue.

*Professionals with no Kentucky Section PGA affiliation will be charged an additional \$ 500.00 if successful in qualifying.

WITHDRAWAL/REFUND POLICY

Requests for refunds must be submitted in writing and will be subject to the following:

1. Prior to deadline > Entry fee refund minus \$5 service fee
2. Prior to the first date of competition > Fee minus \$15 service fee
3. After competition begins > \$0 refund*

*Exception - medical emergency; fee minus \$15 service fee

ELIGIBILITY

Kentucky Section PGA Golf Professionals and Apprentices eligible to compete in Kentucky Section PGA tournament events and Non-Member Kentucky Resident Professionals. An amateur competing in the Kentucky Open shall be required to have an active Handicap Index at a Kentucky Golf Association Member Club at the time of entry. The current USGA Handicap Index shall be based on records effective on the posted revision date.

Entries are subject to approval or rejection, with or without reason, at any time at the discretion of the Kentucky Section PGA.

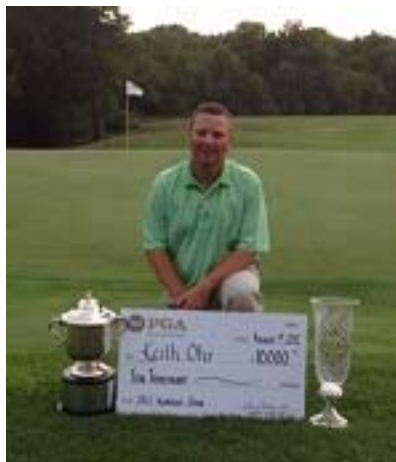
2012 Kentucky Open Championship

HEBRON – Wildwood Country Club PGA Head Professional, Keith Ohr captured his second Kentucky Open Championship at Traditions Golf Club with a score of 8-under-par 208.

Ohr finished one ahead of Pepperdine University junior-to-be Parker Page of Louisville. Page made a valiant effort to reach Ohr during his final round. He recorded six birdies on the front side and with a birdie on the 12th hole, he moved into a share of the lead. Ohr, however prevailed with steady play all day long, finishing with four birdies and only one bogey. Ohr was extremely proud of his second Kentucky Open victory, as he said he really feels like it solidifies his place in Kentucky Golf and backs up his previous win in 2001.

Kyle Wilshire of Scott County, who plays for Central Florida finished three shots back and tied third with University of Kentucky junior-to-be Cody Martin and Cameron Carrico.

Traditions Golf Club played to a par 72 and 7,103 for the 93rd Kentucky Open Championship.
