Conditions of Play

Entries

The Clark's Pump-N-Shop Marathon Kentucky Amateur Championship has been conducted annually since 1911 and has crowned many of the Commonwealth's legendary golfers. Names such as Gay Brewer, Jr., Bobby Nicholas, Frank Beard, John Owens, Bill Musselman, Jodie Mudd and J.B. Holmes are now engraved on the championship trophy.

Field

The 156 player field is cut to the top 70 and ties after 36-holes of competition.

Format

This championship is the flagship tournament for the KGA and is contested over 54 holes of stroke play competition. Players reach the championship by either qualifying at a section site or earning an exemption into the championship field.

Practice Rounds

The official date of the practice round is June 15. Competitors will contact the Big Spring Golf Shop to make arrangements for that date at (502) 458.2027.

Rules of Play

Play is governed by the 2012-2015 Rules of Golf and the Decisions based upon them published by the United States Golf Association and, where applicable, by the following Local Rules and Definitions. Appendix I refers to Appendix of Local Rules in the USGA Rules of Golf booklet. Pace of Play is strictly enforced.

Prizes

All contestants reaching the final round and posting a 54 hole score will receive a gift certificate redeemable through the Big Spring Golf Shop. Prizes will also be awarded in the following categories: Section Medalist, Low Scorer in each round, Low Junior, Low Senior, Low Public Links contestant, Runner-up and Champion.

GEORGETOWN – After what he estimated to be nineteen starts, Tom Campbell of Danville fired a final 2-under-par 70 to secure his victory in the Clark's Pump-N-Shop Marathon Kentucky Amateur at Cherry Blossom Golf Course on June 19. He fought off a wonderful charge by Denver Haddix, Jr. of Lexington, who held the lead on holes #7 and #13 before a steadily playing Campbell overtook his wire-to-wire win. Campbell, 44, admitted he felt nervous during the course of his round but was able to pull through and credits his former players at Centre College (where he was Men's Head Golf Coach and Women's Assistant Basketball Coach) for helping him stick with golf through difficult swing times and keeping his drive alive. Campbell will be moving to Sewanee (The University of the South) to be the Head Women's Basketball Coach in August, though he is planning to bring his accurate ball striking and smart play to the Kentucky Open and Kentucky Match Play Championships before he heads out of town. Many awards were given out to deserving individuals.



The low first round went to Campbell and Haddix, who both fired rounds of 67. The low second round went again to a 67 by Campbell, Joe Deraney and Matt Epperson, both of Lexington. The low final round was an impressive 65 posted by Will Branham of Pikeville. The Low Public Links Golfer (Uncle Joe Dickson Award) went to Runner-Up Haddix. The low juniors (Col. Lee S. Read Award), Billy Tom Sargent of Georgetown and 2013 KGA Player of the Year Fred Allen Meyer of Nicholasville, finished the event at 4-under-par. The low senior amateur award (Harreld Kirkpartick Award) went to Gary Backlund of Mt. Sterling. A special thank you to Luther Conley and his son Steven Of Cherry Blossom Golf Course for hosting a wonderful championship.
