

Colonel Lee Read Award

Established in 1964, this award honors the low junior scorer in the Kentucky State Amateur Championship. The award was presented annually from 1964-1990, and was re-instituted in 2006. The award is named in honor of the late Colonel Lee Read, who is considered the "Father of Junior Golf" in Kentucky. He was a long-time member of the first USGA Junior Golf Committee and served as starter at the USGA Junior Amateur Championship and the U.S. Open Championship for a number of years.
