**CHASE LANDRUM (SR-GLASGOW HS) AND
BAILEY HUBBARD (JR-CLAY COUNTY HS)
NAMED MR. & MS. GOLF; BOYS AND GIRLS
ALL-STATE GOLF TEAMS ANNOUNCED**

LOUISVILLE - Senior Chase Landrum (Glasgow High School) and junior Bailey Hubbard (Clay County High School) are named Mr. & Ms. Golf in Kentucky as the All-State First & Second Team was announced today by Golf House Kentucky and the Kentucky Junior Golf Foundation, Inc.

Landrum totaled 795 points and edged sophomore Cooper Parks (Taylor County High School) based on the first tiebreaker which is the players finish in the 2016 Leachman Buick-GMC-Cadillac KHSAA State Championship. Landrum finished 5th at the State Championship while Parks finished tied for 6th. During the season, Landrum finished with eight Top 10 finishes in Invitational tournaments with three wins and three runner-up finishes. This is the third time Landrum has earned a spot on the First Team including the Mr. Golf award in 2014. Landrum has committed to play golf at Western Kentucky University following graduation.

Hubbard totaled 815 points while making her first appearance on the All State team. During the season, Hubbard finished in the Top 3 in eight Invitational tournaments including two wins and the Region 9 Championship. At the 2016 Leachman Buick-GMC-Cadillac KHSAA State Championship, Hubbard finished in a tie for 5th place. Sophomore MacKenzie Neal (Madison Central High School) finished 25 points behind Hubbard with a total of 790 points.

The All State Golf First and Second Teams are chosen by compiling points in high school Invitational and Regional Tournaments and finalized following the KHSAA State Championship. Invitationals submit their results to the All State Points Committee comprised of Directors from Golf House Kentucky, the Kentucky Junior Golf Foundation, and the Kentucky Golf Coaches Association.

The First Team players and coaches will be honored at the All State Banquet on Saturday, November 5 at Big Spring Country Club. The banquet is sponsored by the Kentucky PGA Junior Tour (Golf House Kentucky) and the Musselman-Dunne Golf Tour (Kentucky Junior Golf Foundation).
