His record on the golf course speaks for itself, but his work ethic and determination are the reasons for his success. Drew has always been a straight A student, and he recently made the Principal's List again in honors classes at St. X. He gives 100%+ in everything he sets his mind to, but golf has always been his passion. He followed in his older brother's footsteps as a successful junior player, and he hopes to also play at the collegiate level, but the resources required to play competitive golf at the regional and especially national level are significant.

Our older son, Brendon, received the Gay Brewer, Jr. Grant in 2011 and again in 2013. We cannot overstate the opportunities the grant offered. He was able to travel to play in events, and compete against the best junior players in the country with the help of the Gay Brewer, Jr. Grant. He was also able to earn a very generous college golf scholarship to Indiana University, due to the exposure he gained.

Although we have always tried to provide opportunities for our children, the past three years have been financially challenging. We suffered a job loss that resulted the reduction of our family income by more than half. We are gradually increasing our income, but it will take us a long time to rebuild our financial stability. The Gay Brewer, Jr. Grant would help us provide the same kinds of opportunities for Drew that we were able to provide our other children.

We have sacrificed the "extras" to provide a Catholic education and extra-curricular activities, but we have expected our children to work as well. Drew has grown up on the golf course and around the game, but he has always known that playing golf is a privilege and that he is extremely fortunate to be able play. He works in the summer on the driving range at Long Run to help cover his tournament entry fees, and the majority of his allowance, Birthday and Christmas money goes directly toward his golf expenses. We believe he works harder because of this investment. We also believe he understands the importance of giving back so that someday others can have the same opportunities.

We believe Drew would make the most of this opportunity by continuing his success at higher levels, and most importantly, he would be very appreciative.
