Congratulations! Your child has been identified as an outstanding player and chosen to be a member of the PGA Junior League Golf All Star Team. Your child will represent the teams in our local league and have the opportunity to go all of the way to the Championship at Grayhawk Golf Club in Scottsdale Arizona on November 16-19, 2017.

We are now headed into Sub-Regional (All-Star) play, which will commence in late July/early August. In preparation for this, please be aware of the following:

- This is a significant commitment for you and your player. We need your child to attend every match and practice. We will provide the schedule for the first match as soon as possible and provide the next match within 24 hours of the previous match.
- 2) The post-season is a travel season. Our first 1-3 matches will probably be close enough for a day trip, as the brackets were formed primarily based on drive times. After that, the distances may increase up to several hours drive and it may be reasonable to expect overnight stays.
- 3) Post-season play is single elimination. If we lose a match, our season will conclude.
- 4) While the regular season is recreational-level competition and invites players of all levels to participate, the post-season teams are more competitive, but still fun.
- 5) Please watch the Parent and player <u>Conduct and Rule (video)</u>. While the post-season is more competitive, we would like to remind you that:
 - a. The competition is between the players.
 - b. The competition is friendly, fun and the players are children.

- i. Match play in August (Schedule To be determined by Captains)
- ii. Sub-Regional Championship August 27th (Quail Chase in Louisville, Kentucky)
- iii. Regionals September 30-October 1 (The Bridgewater Club in Carmel, Indiana) ***
- iv. National Championship November 16 -19 (Grayhawk Golf Club in Scottsdale, Arizona)

*** Special Note: The Regionals conflict with the KPGA Middle School State Championship. If you choose to play in the KPGA Middle School State Championship then you will not be able to be a member of the PGA Jr. League All Star Team as we need your full commitment to each stage of the competition.
