Player Grant Program Goal

Generate \$10,000 in support of the Kentucky PGA Junior Tour which creates at least 25 memberships and 50 Tournament entries for players with financial need while supporting the overall mission of the Kentucky PGA Junior Tour. Contributions would be made payable to the Kentucky Golf Foundation and considered a 100% tax deductible contribution.

Kentucky PGA Junior Tour Mission

The Tour celebrates 25 seasons of providing high quality tournaments for junior golfers throughout the state of Kentucky with past golfers progressing to play competitive golf at colleges and universities, pursuing careers in the business of golf, or making their mark in the professional ranks. Tour members learn about the Rules and etiquette of the game while fine tuning their abilities during tournament play and building friendships with fellow-competitors.

Contribution Allocation

50% of each contribution will support the Player Grant Fund and the remaining contribution will support the mission of the Kentucky PGA Junior Tour.

Event Recognition Opportunity

Recognition through a logo on event scorecards and signage in the scoring area provided for contributions exceeding \$400. For every \$400 in support, one junior golfer from Kentucky will receive a Player Grant.

Reserved Player Grant Funds

Total contributions in excess of \$1,200 would support at least three junior golfers, and those funds may be reserved for players from specific counties in Kentucky.
