If Turner's campus has a digital marquee in front, the rest of Breathitt County should have a look. His 1-under 71 gave him medalist honors, and it was Saturday's only sub-par score.

"I liked the greens, the speed of (them)," Turner said of Hidden Cove's layout. "(Fairways) were a little bit narrow for me, but I hit my driver pretty good, so I liked it overall."

The 71 was Turner's best during the high school season, but it was not his lowest this year. He fired 2-under 70s in Kentucky Junior PGA events this summer in Prestonsburg and Lexington.

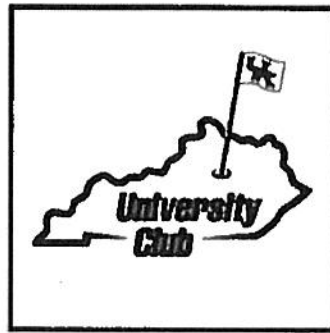

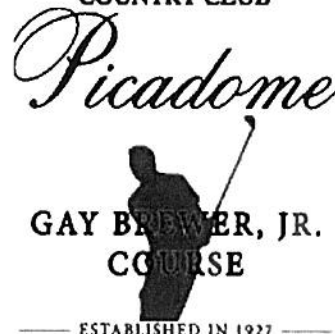
