When I began playing competitive golf, Todd was the Head Professional at the Country Club of Paducah. He always carried himself as a true professional and treated members and nonmembers with the same respect and courteousness. After some 12 years, he left to open the Golf Complex to focus on his passion of teaching. The Golf Complex now employs 4 PGA certified instructors and does thousands of lessons and fittings a year.

While sheer numbers don't make a "Hall of Famer", the accomplishments of his students and his own awards certainly do. Todd was on the PGA Ky Board of Directors from 1996-1998, honored as the Kentucky PGA teacher of the year in 2006, 2008, 2009, and 2013, and the Top Teacher in Ky by Golf Digest in 2011 and 2012. The most impressive thing to me is the number of students that he has helped to receive golf scholarships and then go on to play professional golf. I have attached his student list at the bottom of this letter, but a few highlights would be Josh Teater – PGA Tour, Patrick Newcomb – Web Tour, Rick Cochran III – Web Tour, Emma Talley – LPGA and Past NCAA Champion. His passion for teaching juniors is really where he shines.

A few years ago, my swing was having some issues, my teacher had just taken a new job at the Greenbrier, and I was in need of some swing help. I immediately reached out to Todd. He explained that he was extremely booked up and could hardly see me since I live two hours away and could only do weekends. After he asked around about me to make sure I was serious, he emailed me back and said he could meet a couple times a month at 6am on Saturday mornings. I was extremely impressed with his teaching and quickly got my swing back together. However, I was much more impressed about how he was willing to help and his passion towards the game of golf.
